POSITIVE PATHS STUDENT RULES & REGULATIONS

In order for me to participate in the Positive Paths Program offered by the American Indian Center, I agree to follow the rules & regulations (in *italics*) stated below. I understand that if I break the rules and regulation I will suffer the consequences of my actions. These consequences may include:

- Not being allowed to participate in an activity;
- Calling my parents and having them come to get me early;
- Not being able to return to the next Positive Paths summer session;
- Not being able to return to 1 month of Positive Paths summer sessions;
- Not being able to participate in a Positive Paths summer field trip;
- Or I may be asked not to return to the program for the rest of the summer.

I agree to follow these rules:

- I will always bring my homework to tutoring, if I do not have homework then I know I will have to read or work on my other school skills for at least 1 hour.
- *I will be respectful to the mentors and other students in the program, this means I will not swear at anyone else, I will not fight with anyone else, and I will try to be kind to other people.*
- *I will not come to Positive Paths under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.*
- *I will always help clean-up after myself and help clean the Positive Paths program area at the end of every session.*
- *I will treat all of our guest speakers with respect and will pay attention during their presentations.*
- *I will try my best to work with mentors during activities other work even when I don't feel like it.*
- I know that if I do not bring my homework communication forms in then I can not participate in drum practice or other special activities.

POSITIVE PATHS PARENT/GUARDIAN CONTRACT

For my child to participate in the Positive Paths After-School Program (the "Program") at the American Indian Center, I agree to the requirements (in *italics*) set forth below. My initials next to each bullet point ensure that I have read and understood each requirement.

- I will contribute to at least three tutoring sessions during each semester by providing my time, talent, knowledge, or assistance. (I understand that my participation could include tutoring, volunteering at an event, preparing food, talking about my job, assisting in an art project, or otherwise sharing my cultural knowledge.)
- *I will maintain contact with the Positive Paths coordinator by having my child sign into the Program on a daily basis.*
- I will provide the Program coordinator with my child's report card, progress reports; ITBS test results, and Iowa test results.
- I agree to have my child's teacher fill-out weekly homework reports and will ensure my child brings them to tutoring every Tuesday or Thursday if they do not come on Tuesday.
- *I will participate in the review of and the setting of goals for the Program.*
- *I or another authorized adult will be available to pick my child up at anytime during the summer program, should the need arise.*
- *I agree that if the Program coordinator were to inform me that my child violated any Program rules and were to ask that my child take a day off from the Program, I will not bring them to the Program.*
- *I will make a good faith effort to resolve any conflicts that may arise.*
- *I will not be allowed to pick-up my child (for legal and safety reasons) if I am under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.*
- *I have been given and have read a copy of the Program rules.*

Should I fail to follow through on any of these requirements, I understand that my child will not be able to participate in the program.
